For legal reasons, we cannot accept certain materials, including:

- Asbestos
- Any compressed gas cylinder (Gas bottles, Calor, Balloon gas, Oxygen, Acetylene)
- Batteries (including households, car or lorry batteries)
- Chemicals (for example, cleaning products, hair dyer, photographic chemicals)
- Clinical waste (healthcare waste)
- Fridges
- Liquids (such as cooking oil, engine oil, hydraulic oil, bleach)
- Solvents (for example paint, glue)
- TV
- Tyres
- Computer towers
- Computer screens
- Electric fans
- Electric cookers
- Kettles
- Microwaves
- Phones
- Toasters
